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At Meir Heath Academy, each child starts their reading journey in the Early Years Foundation Stage, Reception. The children are introduced to a new book each day of the week during story time. Monday's text is a recommendation from a pupil, Tuesday's text is topic related, Wednesday's text is a democratic vote, Thursday's text is a religious/cultural story, Friday's text is linked to British values/fable. Then a text linked to each Topic is shared in their Literacy lessons.

<b>EYFS</b>						
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The reading journey is continued in Y1 to Y6 by sharing and studying texts linked to topics (see below). Story time at the end of the day is celebrated through the school. These texts are to promote a love of reading. In Y1, on a daily basis, each child has the opportunity to vote for their favourite book out of two choices. The book that receives most votes is then read out to the whole class. In each class every week, a child is selected to complete a recommended read activity, where they write about and share one of their favourite stories.
