

Part B: Review of the outcomes from the previous academic year

Pupil Premium Strategy Outcomes

This details the impact that our pupil premium activity had on pupils in the 2025 to 2026 academic year.

Improved progress and attainment for pupil premium pupils.	Whole School Pupil Premium attainment: Maths 79% Phonics 100% Reading 84% Writing 74%
Improved social and emotional regulation, alongside improved self-esteem and intrinsic motivation.	Attendance for the academic year 2025-2026 Whole School:97% Non-Pupil Premium: 97% Pupil Premium: 94% (1 pupil persistent absentee and 1 pupil on a PTTT).
Improved access to a range of clubs and extra-curricular opportunities for our disadvantaged children	7 / 21 pupils attended teacher led after school enrichment clubs (an increase of 3 pupils from last academic year). Pupil voice gathered around enrichment clubs and all clubs requested by PP pupils have been offered this academic year. Reasons for non-attendance include, already attend clubs after school with parents. 8 / 21 pupils trialled and attended music tuition. 17 out of 25 pupil premium and service children have taken up the offer of free breakfast and break-time snacks.

Measure	Details
How did you spend your service pupil premium allocation last academic year?	Learning Support Assistants dedicated to the emotional wellbeing and academic achievement of pupil premium and service children. They plan and implement sessions for socially speaking and time to talk to help develop confidence in the social use of language and emotional literacy. They also carried out a daily 'meet and greet' session to aid a smooth transition between home and school. Weekly and incidental emotional coaching sessions are delivered weekly and daily (as required) in response to identified individual pupil need.
What was the impact of that spending on service pupil premium eligible pupils?	Attendance: 97.9% Service children have above national attendance. Attendance is good. 100% of service children are attaining EXS+ in reading, writing and maths.
